## FAQ's Regarding the MET and TIPI Courses

- Q - *Although your courses are approved by the Ohio Physical Therapy Association for Continuing Education, will my state also be accepted?*
- A - Individual states may vary due to their certification boards; however states that touch Ohio accept reciprocity. Upon completion of the course, we provide you with the documentation to secure your state's credits.
- Q - *Do the courses need to be taken in order?*
- A - The courses can be taken in any order, because they cover different techniques for the various parts of the anatomy. However, the order in which you treat the patient tends to flow from M1 to the M2, so I recommend M1 before M2.
- Q - *Do I need to purchase the manual prior to taking the course?*
- A - The fully illustrated manuals are included in the seminar fee, and they are the scripts that we filmed the DVDs from.
- Q - *Can I earn CEUs for watching the DVDs?*
- A - No, because your hands-on techniques must be evaluated during the lab sessions.
- Q - *Is there anything I can do to prepare for the course?*
- A - Several students have told us that it enhanced their experience to watch the M1 & M2 DVDs in advance of the course and then the You Tube videos afterward as reference of exact hand placement for the various techniques.
- Q - *Are the courses offered on-line?*
- A - No, because your hands-on techniques must be evaluated during the lab sessions.
